# **Activity:**

- Incidents since last Board Meeting:

- Region is reporting an increase in Covid cases (FD).

# **Equipment:**

- Apparatus Update
  - Enigne 1 (In Service) received its annual Pump test.
    - Scene light replacement on going, Antenna replacement, Quick release for power cord
  - Engine 2 is placed in Reserve Status.
    - Outside reveiw of E-2 attached
    - Parked in back, Winterization scheduled, cover being ordered
  - o Tender 4 (In Service)
  - Tender 5 (Out of service)
    - Currently at shops, having inductors and a pump replaced.
  - Brush 6 (Out of service)
    - Currently at shop for replumbing of water pipes
  - Command 7 (In Service), Three Points Fire District vechicle.
  - Tender 8 (In Service) Returned to service Oct 2
  - o FR 10 (In Service)
  - Brush 11 (In service and running well)
  - Water Trailer (Out of service) Pending repairs
  - Porta Tank (4,000 gallons) deployment continues to be discussed.

#### Station

 The electrical project is proceeding to next phase, Emergency Power.

- Station smoke detectors purchased, fire extinguishers inventoried and replaced as necessary.
- Hose packs tested and repacked, 4 additional packs obtained from Highlands Fire.
- Apron project does not require NEPA permit, researching how to proceed.
- Meetings/discussion on best process for repeater system and improvement of the radio system is ongoing.

# Training:

Last training October 14 included 7 members of SFEFD. Topics covered included first aid basics and basic radio procedures. Next training dates are November 7 and November 18. The only training for December will be December 5.

#### **District Notes:**


- Fire Safety Week this month. Obtained additional dry chem extinguishers and planning extinguisher fire training in the future.
- On October 8 a walk through at Kadampa. The Retreat is operating on a skeleton staff and is suffering from low attendance due to Covid. This meeting topics inlouded developing a pre-fire plan, training retreat staff and sharing resources.
- State Forestry future weather forecast that states winter to be dry and cold. "It's been a long season and its not done. We are estimating the season to continue for the next 50 days". Possible cold spell starting Friday. Inciweb reports 21 active fires in AZ.
- Administration issues include continuing to develop the new recruit process, outlining a driver trainer process, work comp program, and development of privacy policy for new members.
- Pay adjustment for Matt and Brie request.
- Lifeline Ambulance (Williams) is reporting a significant turnover with its personnel, monitor to idenfiy any impact to community.
- Oct 15 site visit with Work Comp.
- State Land Annexation Proposal.



# Income and Expense by Month July 1 through October 20, 2020








