

Minutes of June 16th, 2026, Board Meeting

The Fire Board of the Sherwood Forest Estates Fire District met in Regular session, held at the fire house at 450 Little John Road, Williams, Arizona. The following topics and any variables there too were subject to Board consideration, discussion, approval, or other action.

1. Call to order at 5:00pm
2. Pledge of Allegiance
3. Roll Call: Walt Krushinsky (Chairperson), Dan Rousch (after swearing in), Debra Hamby (Clerk). Also attending, Matt McDowell (Chief) and Chuck Pruett (assistant Chief). Public – Sign in sheet recorded
4. Nominations and vote to a third member to the Board: Walt K. nominated Dan Rousch, Debra H. second – he was then sworn in.
5. Voted to move to an Executive Session: Debra made the motion to move to an Executive Session, Walt K. second. When returning Walt K. made the motion to resume regular Board meeting and Debra H. second.
6. Minutes: May 2026, Board Meeting: Motion made by Walt K. to accept the minutes and seconded by Debra H. and the board voted unanimously to accept.
7. Treasurer's Report: May 2026 Financial details: Walt K. read the overview w/ income at 107.4% and expenditures were at 110.4% of budget. Debra asked about the very old checks that have not been cleared yet and Matt said he will check into it. Debra H. made a motion to accept the financial report, and Walt K. seconded, and board unanimously voted to accept.
8. Budget: The Board approved the 2026-2027 Budget. As of today, the budget has been posted for 1 month. Once Walt gets the June financials, he will submit the budget to the County.
